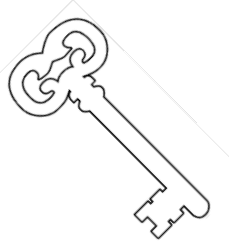


# Y10 English Language and Literature Revision



## English Literature

- **Re-read** your Literature texts – you need to know them inside out.
- Use GCSE Pod to revise **plot, character** and **themes** for each text (Jekyll & Hyde or A Christmas Carol, Blood Brothers or An Inspector Calls).
- For each text create a **plot overview** (images, storyboard, key quotations, bullet points, paragraphs).
- Create **character profiles or flashcards** – key quotations, key relationships, key events and themes for each quotation).
- Use revision websites to **gather alternative views and readings of characters** (Sparknotes, BBC Bitesize, Cliffsnotes, Shmoop).
- Complete Jekyll and Hyde/ A Christmas Carol **homework booklets**.
- Complete **'Poetry on a page'** document – thorough revision notes needed here.

## English Language

- Read **news articles** online or in newspapers e.g. BBC, The Independent, The Guardian, The Times etc.) and focus on writer's viewpoints and how they are shared.
- **Read** – read widely and read anything from instructions to leaflets to articles to short stories to novels etc.
- **Review notes in your books for Component 1** and both of your Component 1 papers (Megan on the train and Patricia in the fire).
