We are pleased to announce the launch of our **SAS revision & support sessions**. This stands for Saturday and Sixth Form.

These sessions will take place on a Saturday from **10:00** until **12:00 at Banovallum**. Whilst there, they will have the opportunity to receive support in a number of ways: one-to-one tuition & mentoring; small lectures and small group sessions. These will be provided by our SAS coaches who have been specially recruited from the QEGS Sixth Form for their high level of knowledge and ability in a variety of subjects. The coaches are in the unique position of having recently completed GCSEs successfully and can guide them not only in subjects but also, crucially, in examination preparation. Many of the SAS Coaches are former Banovallum students, who are keen to support the current Year 11.

Last year this was a huge success for Banovallum. Those students who attended **regularly** made at least a grade's improvement from what they have been predicted. All students who attended five or more sessions on a Saturday passed their English and Maths and therefore do not need to re-sit them this year.


